Special Events Volunteers:

At Forge, we hold multiple special events throughout the year. Because these events require much work to pull off, it is always helpful to have additional people on hand to help with the planning, set up, and execution of those times. These are some of the ways we can use special event volunteers:

- Before:
 - Cleaning & Set-up
 - Food preparation
 - A/V set-up
 - Snow removal (for winter events)

- During:
 - Registration and Greeting
 - Parking attendants
 - Ushers
 - A/V assistance
 - Photography/videography assistance

- After:
 - Resource table
 - Tear-down

Administrative/Headquarters Volunteers:

Keeping the nuts and bolts of a ministry running takes a lot of work. Administrative volunteers assist the Forge staff by helping with various general operations items. Some of the opportunities available for those interested in serving administratively are:

Summer Volunteers:
